#### **Level of Commitment**

Once elected by the Board of Directors, each new Fellow makes a commitment to give a gift to The New York Bar Foundation of \$2,000. This gift can be completed immediately, or there is a flexibility to pay \$200 per year for ten years. Upon completion of the commitment, you become part of this distinguished group with the designation as a Life Fellow. Once receiving the Life Fellow designation Fellows are invited to move up to higher Circles of Giving.

Each Circle of Giving has been named for a highly respected individual who has dedicated his or her life to the law and the advancement of the legal profession:

## Maryann Saccomando Freedman Circle - \$3,000 Pledge

Requires a minimum gift of \$300 each year until pledge is fulfilled

## Charles Evans Hughes Circle - \$5,000 Pledge

Requires a minimum gift of \$500 each year until pledge is fulfilled

## Benjamin N. Cardozo Circle - \$10,000 Pledge

Requires a minimum gift of \$1,000 each year until pledge is fulfilled

## Thurgood Marshall Circle - \$25,000 Pledge

Requires a minimum gift of \$2,500 each year until pledge is fulfilled

### **Learned Hand Circle - \$50,000 Pledge**

Requires a minimum gift of \$5,000 each year until pledge is fulfilled
